Kercheval Dance Safe Return Protocols and Policies:

- Staff will be in attendance during all class hours to ensure all protocols are followed
- Staff and dancers are the only people permitted in the building during class hours
- · Reduced class sizes
- Clearly marked dance spaces to promote social distancing
- Teachers have been trained and are prepared to conduct classes to allow for social distancing
- Masks at all times
- No food permitted
- Consistent sanitization of all spaces

Dancers

- All dancers must wear masks before AND DURING their dance classes.
- · Classes will end early to allow for dismissal and sanitization
- Wear easy to remove shoes
- Temperatures taken at entrance. Dancers with a temperature above 100.3 will not be permitted in the studio. (Dancers may take any missed classes via zoom)
- Hand sanitizer will be used before and after class.
- Dancers should bring a small bag that contains their dance shoes, water bottle and any personal belongings necessary for class. Their dance bag will be placed in their designated cubby.
- Any dancer who does not comply with the required protocols will be asked to continue future classes virtually on Zoom.

PARENTS

- Parents will not be allowed to enter the studio during class hours.
- Parents will drop off or wait outside with their dancers until a Kercheval Dance staff member escorts them in.
- Any questions regarding payments, etc. should be done over the phone or via email.
- A signed Registration Form must be on file for each participating student.
- Parents must consider the following before bringing their child to dance each day:
- Have they or their child experienced any of the following symptoms recently? Fever or chills, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, muscle or body aches, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, nausea or vomiting, diarrhea? If yes, stay home.
- Have you participated in international travel by airplane in the last 14 days? If yes, stay home.
- In the last 14 days, have you had contact with a confirmed/probable COVID-19 case? If yes, stay home.
- Kercheval Dance will have Konnect*Live Zoom class options available for dancers to participate from home.
- If an event occurs classes may move to Konnect*Live Zoom (virtual) classes until it is safe to return to in person classes.
